The objective of the workshops is to assist participants in the process of creating individualized housing and support plans.

HOW IT WORKS

The workshop series helps participants to envision what a life of independence looks like; determine their skills and strengths and explore how technology can fill any gaps.

Participants then examine the resources a person has and what they will need to acquire to create and implement a plan that is sustainable, yet flexible, so as to adjust with the changing needs of the person.

Through the completion of the budget spreadsheet, participants can then experiment with different scenarios to see if an idea is worth trying, and to help determine where there may be opportunities to increase independence and reduce costs.

RESULTS

The workshop provides tools and resources aimed at supporting the creation of truly individualized housing plans and a defendable budget. By identifying and obtaining housing and supports that truly meet the person where they are at, the program aims to create long-term satisfaction and sustainability.
